The Portuguese National Agency for Erasmus + Youth / Sports and European Solidarity Corps and the National Office for Erasmus + Ukraine are looking for 8 (eight) organizers to co-create an event that supports learning and networking of participants through the Webinar **“Erasmus + Future Focused for Youth Ukraine”**. This activity will happen online and all the production and management will be hosted in Portugal, by the Portuguese National Agency and the National Office Erasmus + Ukraine.

"EFFY | Erasmus+ Future Focused Youth – Ukraine"

The “EFFY23” proposal intends to reinforce the collaboration with the National Erasmus+ Office - Ukraine to empower Ukrainian and European Youth Actors with renovated partnerships towards the Erasmus+ cooperation.

Co-organisers: Ministry of Youth and Sport of Ukraine, Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, Salto-Youth Resource Centres, Information Centre Erasmus+ Youth and European Solidarity Corps – Ukraine, ESN – Ukraine, Young European Ambassadors, Ukraine Youth Council Association.

6. Full description

Focused on the values of the European Union (EU) and the sense of belonging to the EU project, this Conference/Webinar aim to explore Erasmus+ Projects as a powerful tool to promote Solidarity, Social Inclusion, Active Participation, Democracy, Tolerance, Peace, and Human Rights.

It will strengthen partnership between EU and Ukrainian youth organisations to contribute to the Recovery Plan of Ukraine in Youth sector.

The main Goal is to increase knowledge about the Erasmus+ Programme and to encourage participants to use youth projects as a tool to develop, promote and implement projects within their contexts, with strong focus on solidarity, social inclusion of young migrants, refugees, temporarily relocated and of young people arriving from difficult backgrounds or contexts to new countries and to new local communities.

The Webinar will focus on Erasmus+ KA1, KA2 Cooperation Partnership and European Solidarity Corps empowerment and foster Network capacity within all Conference participants.

In this way, the activity had the following objectives:

- to reinforce the awareness about European Values and on Erasmus+ Programme;
- to ensure a thorough understanding of the Erasmus+ Programme in general and KA1, KA2 Projects and ESC in particular;
- to introduce and explore Youth Projects as a powerful tool to promote Solidarity, and Social Inclusion, Active Participation, Democracy, Tolerance, Peace, Human Rights and to respond to common challenges due to russian invasion to Ukraine;
- to explore and understand the different roles within Youth cooperation Projects and different phases and dimensions on it planning and implementation;
- to support the development of cooperation under KA1 and KA2 Projects and cooperation for ESC;
- to provide space for sharing realities, to exchange practices, experiences, points of view and ideas for the future;
- to inspire and create spaces for the planning of further Youth Projects and the action plans for the adaptation of current projects;
- to share the key findings of the Strategic Cooperation under Erasmus+ KA1 and KA2 and ESC projects;
- to summarize the recommendations and providing space for reflecting on the implications of the key findings on youth work realities on Ukraine.

The two-days seminar will focus on the state of play, especially in relation to the key topics of:

- Designing quality KA1 and KA2 Projects and opportunities for young people;
- Supporting the networking and cooperation for ESC partnerships;
- Role of policies and EU programmes in quality development of youth activities;
- Competences, training, and assessment on implementing Cooperation within KA1 and KA2 projects.
- Ways forward - Social transformation and future focused development of youth activities
- Exploring transferable practices of youth work and non-formal education.

Methodology & Technical requirements:

The webinar is designed to empower participants, youth workers, youth professionals with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively design and cooperate within Erasmus KA1 and KA2 Projects and ESC projects.

The main objective of the webinar is to raise awareness about the opportunities and potential of Erasmus+ cooperation with Ukrainian Actors through KA1, KA2 Cooperation for Partnerships a Projects ESC Projects.

The webinar will be delivered through a combination of interactive online sessions, presentations, and group network sessions. Participants will have the opportunity to engage with expert trainers and peers, and to share their own experiences and insights.

Agenda is designed for 2 Days of online Work, (9.30h CET to 14h CET) with cultural events and other interactive opportunities to engage participants into the partnerships and motivation to initiate and consolidate the interest and knowledge to implement projects with Ukrainian partners already by the deadline of October 2023.

This webinar is *for* a maximum of 900 participants from - Erasmus+ Youth Program countries and Ukraine.

- The activity will happen in Portugal on the **28th and 29th June 2023;**
- The team of organizers selected need to be available for the online preparation meetings that will happen on the **2/06/2023, 9/06/2023 and 20/06/2023;**
- The team needs to arrive on the **25th June** and we will have **2 preparation days in presence (26th and 27th June)**, before the webinar;
- After the activity the team will evaluate the event and produce a report for the organizers;
- Some positions of the team can implement their tasks 100% online.

The Team will be composed by members that can perform with high quality the following Tasks & Responsibilities:

- Prepare the working sessions on KA1, KA2 and ESC according to the objectives of the Webinar;

- Good communication in English (written and verbal);
- Able to ensure a good cooperation environment and communication that fosters future partnerships in Erasmus + Youth;
- Proactive, organized, good team work skills;
- Available for the online preparation meetings (2nd, 9th and 20th June morning) and the in-presence preparation 26 and 27th and the event 28 and 28th June in-presence in Portugal;
- Able to manage online communication in big events and keeping focus and friendly attitude in a webinar produced in a TV setting (*only for 2 members of the team*);
- Able to prepare and run a communication strategy that supports the objectives of the event (social media moderation) – *only for 2 members of the team*
